Q: Why is Algeria Campsite closed?

A: Due to extensive damage caused by devastating flood events in 2023 and 2024 CapeNature has closed the Algeria Campsite for a two-year period to allow for a full redesign and rebuilding. This is to ensure the campsite is resilient against future weather events.

Q: When will Algeria Campsite reopen?

A: The Algeria Campsite is anticipated to be closed for two years. We will update our guests as the project progresses and let you know once bookings can be made.

Q: Is the entire reserve closed?

A: No, the cottages and trails remain open as usual.

Q: Can I still camp at other CapeNature campsites?
